What to know before you apply:

Before you apply, it is a good idea to visit www.americorps.gov to learn more about AmeriCorps.

- Agencies may not use AmeriCorps members in a way that will displace an employee or position or infringe on an employee's promotional opportunities. Members may not fill in for an absent employee or perform services, duties, or activities that have been assigned to an employee or to an employee who has recently resigned or been discharged.
- Agencies are required to provide an in-kind and financial match to help supplement member costs.
- Members will engage in mandatory monthly training events hosted by *AmeriCorps for the Adirondacks*.
- Member will work to recruit and train community volunteers to assist agencies with increasing their capacity to provide quality community services.

To Sponsor an AmeriCorps *State member:

- Public/private nonprofits
- Tribal Nations

- Institutions of higher education

To apply you must submit:

1. A completed Application to become an AmeriCorps Sponsor
2. A copy of the AmeriCorps members supervisor's résumé and organizational job description
3. An organizational chart
4. Please make sure that you include all requested attachment's in your application packet

You may submit all application materials either by mail, e-mail, or fax.
